Across Imagine Education Group, each of our centres has its own library, providing a wonderful opportunity to strengthen the connection between learning at the centre and learning at home.

Through the Fusion Inquiry Framework, we value creating meaningful shared learning experiences between children, families, and educators.

This aligns closely with our Guiding Mantras of *Language as a Priority and Connection – Every Child, Every Family, Every Educator.*



Within our centres, we use the Abecedarian Approach Australia, which is supported through learning games such as **See, Show, Say** to encourage children's language and literacy development. This learning game promotes interactive reading experiences by slowing down, looking closely at pictures, pointing, naming, and engaging in conversation together during story time.



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How You Can Support This at Home

Choose picture books with clear, simple images and short text.

Pause during reading to ask questions such as:

“What do you see?”

“Can you show me the dog?”

or “What is this called?”

Point to pictures and clearly name objects, actions, or emotions to help build vocabulary.

Allow your child to take the lead by pointing, showing, or naming things that interest them throughout the story.



Remember, reading together is not about finishing the whole book — it is about enjoying the interaction, conversation, and shared learning experience together.

We encourage all families to continue accessing our Centre Library and enjoying these special reading moments at home with your child.
