Created in partnership with Aunty Sharron Mirii Bell, “I Am Me” invites children to sing, connect, and build confidence in who they are.

This resource aligns with the Fusion Inquiry Framework and Imagine Education Group’s Project of Intention – Children’s Voices: How we feel safe in our community (Centre, Home, and Neighbourhood), supporting children to express their identity, share their voice, and develop a strong sense of safety, belonging, and connection.

We will be using this resource to support conversations and learning around:

- who we are
- where we belong
- how we can express ourselves
- and how we can respect and celebrate others

This connects closely with our focus on children’s voice, wellbeing, and rights, helping children feel safe, valued, and heard in their environment.
